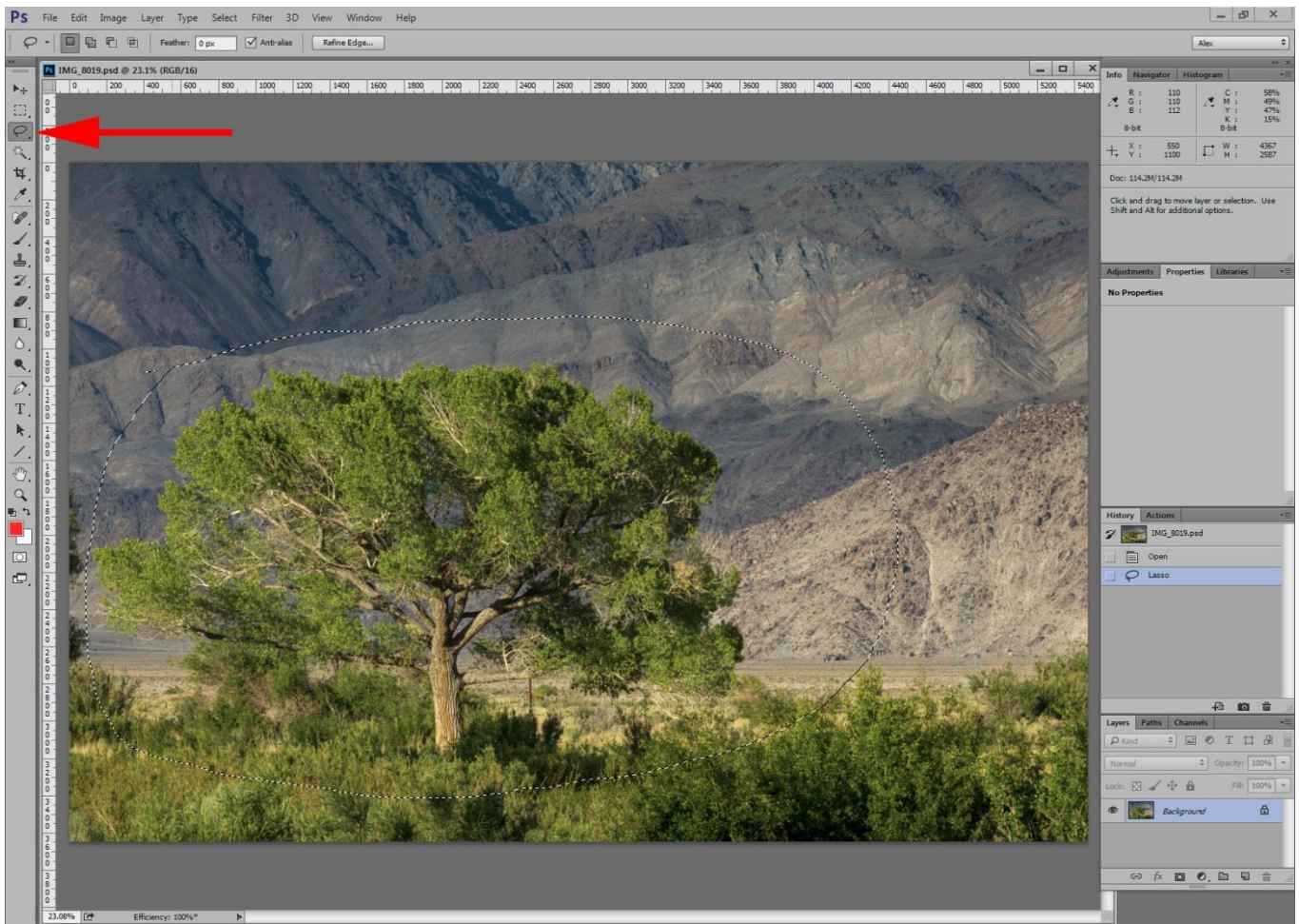


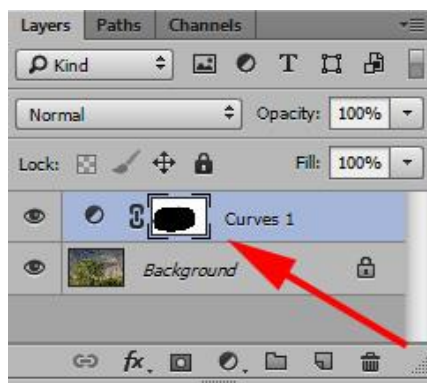
Vignetting Images

Photoshop

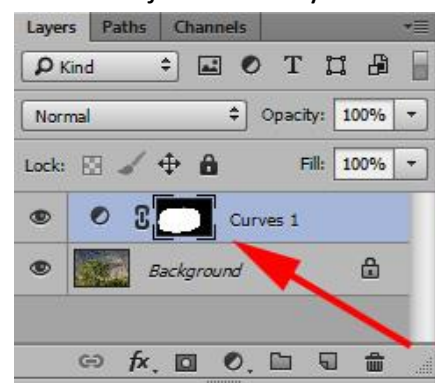
1. Use 'Lasso' Selection Tool to draw the vignette shape on the image.



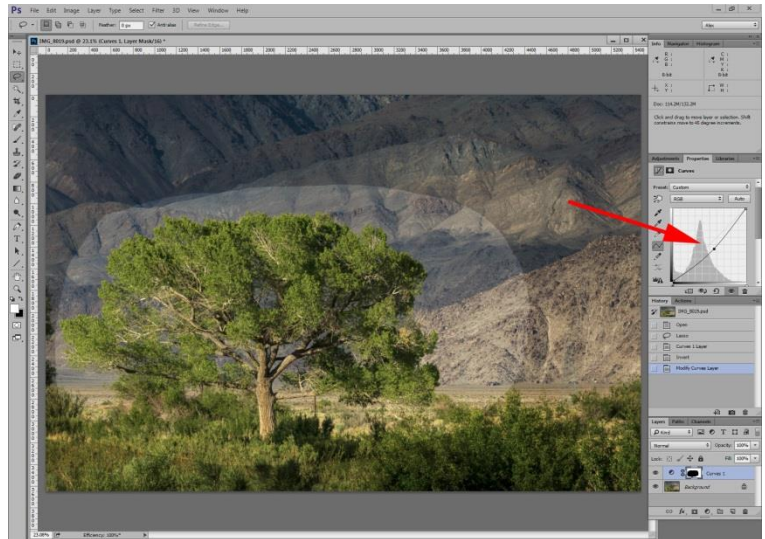
2. Create a new 'Curves' Adjustment layer.



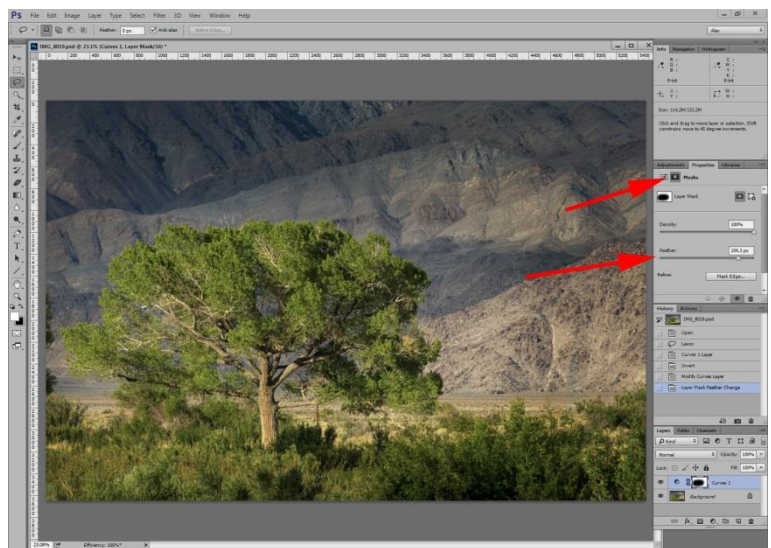
3. Press 'Ctrl' + 'I' to invert the Curves Adjustment layer's mask.



- Click on the curves line in the curves **'Properties'** window and pull down to darken the image. You should see only the non-masked areas (outside) of the image darken.



- Click the **'Mask'** icon in the **'Properties'** window and **'Feather'** the mask. Depending on image size but anywhere from 150 to 300 pixels on average.



- To reduce look of vignette use the **Layer 'Opacity'** slider.



- Can also adjust look by altering the curve in the **'Properties'** window.
