A REFLECTION

Reflection photos refer to any shot, no matter what type of photography genre, that use a reflective surface. Landscape photography, with a mountain duplicated in the still water of a lake, is reflection photography.



SOMEONE* YOU LOVE

Any image depicting someone to whom you feel a sense of 'love' towards : This can include children, family, lovers, friends, or even yourself.

*'Someone' usually refers to human beings, but by default may be understood to mean all 'living beings'. Therefore, within the spirit of inclusivity, your beloved pet may be included.



MONOCHROME

Monochrome photography is about taking one single colour and using a range of tones of that colour to colourize an image. Rather than having colours from all over the spectrum, a monochrome photo has just one color scale.

Note: The actual 'subject' itself is open, however the image needs to be developed or executed in black and white or in varying tones of only one colour.



ARCHITECTURE

Architecture photography (also referred to as building or structure photography) generally means photography that focuses on buildings. It can include building exteriors & interiors, as well as bridges, other structures & cityscapes.



LANDSCAPE

Photography that focuses on capturing natural environments, such as mountains, forests, beaches, & other natural features. This type of photography emphasizes the beauty of the natural world and often seeks to capture a sense of awe. It can include examples using long exposure, wide-angle lenses, and panoramic compositions.



BOOKS

Includes any image of a book or books. These can be positioned in different environments and locations. While other elements may form part of the image, the main emphasis needs to be the book/s.



AN ACTION SHOT

Action photography captures the energy of movement of a subject or subjects. This can include a person jumping, an animal running, a child playing (running, jumping, swinging). Strong action shots can use slow or fast shutter speeds & 'panning'.



AN EMPTY ROAD

Any road or thoroughfare which is void of 'contents', that is, missing people, cars, or animals. 'Emptiness' needs to be the emphasis, within the setting of a road, or pathway / thoroughfare.



SOMETHING WEIRD

Strange, Weird, & Unique: let your "Photography" imagination run wild! Look for the unusual or 'odd' in your subject matter.

Note: The image can be either 'natural' or 'contrived' (ie, set up).
